## LIFE-SAVING SURGERIES

In 2017, Robin Post and I joined Animal Fix Clinic to help community cats by providing affordable spay/neuter options. Today, our TNR program accounts for 45% of our patients, and we've seen over 3,269 community cats come through our clinic in 2022 alone. In addition to working with community cats, we also provide spay/neuter surgeries for companion animals, as well as life-saving surgeries for pets of families who are unable to afford the prohibitive cost of veterinary care.

## ACCESS TO CARE

All in all, AFC staff helped a record number of over 7,000 patients in 2022, while maintaining an outstanding level of care. Our team of technicians is proud to offer exemplary practices in anesthesia, pain management, and compassionate patient handling. AFC is dedicated to the "Access to Care" movement, and we are continually striving to meet the growing demand for our services. We recently purchased our own building and plan to move into our bigger, improved facility soon. Our goal is to continue expanding our practice to help even more animals in our community. 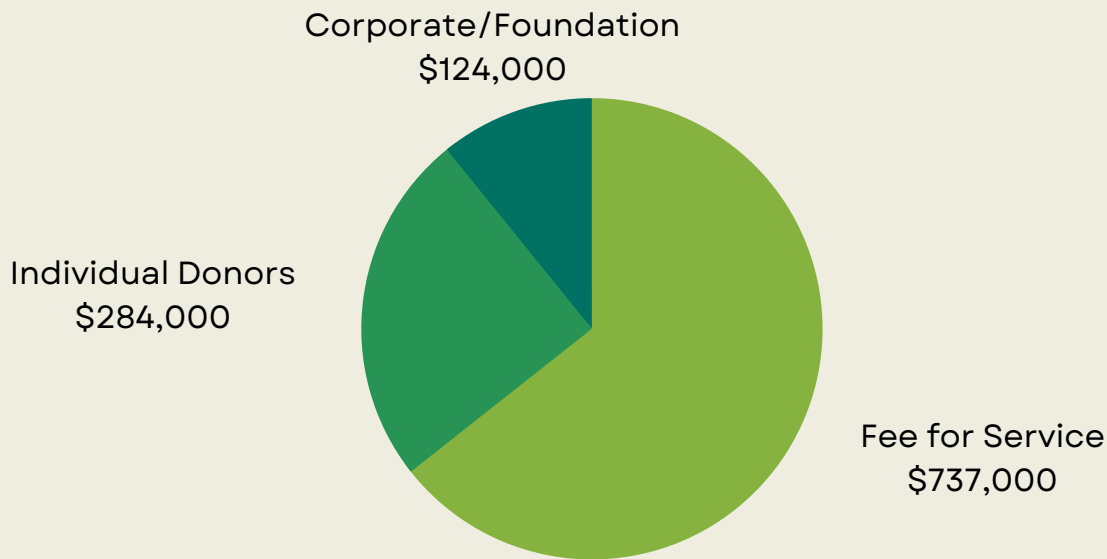

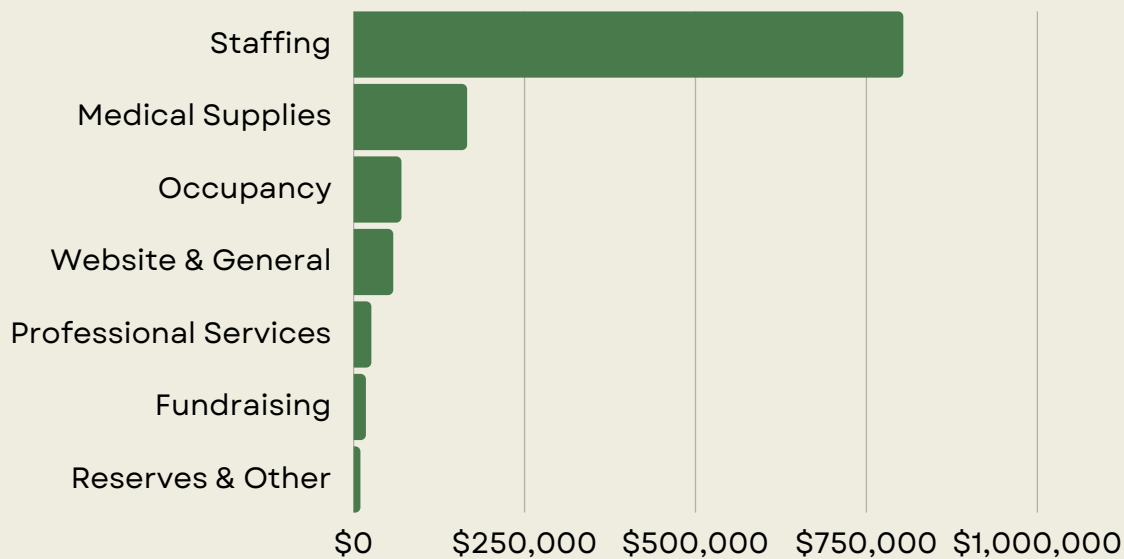
